ENTRIES Use RMDS entry form. You can find it in the Omnibus or online at RMDS.org. Click Forms, click Show, click Entry Form. Send entries to secretary with check made to "Foothills Chapter." Proof of horse vaccination for equine influenza virus and equine herpes virus within six months of show must be included with entry. Completely fill in entry and sign all spaces on front and back. Please print legibly. Include proof of negative Coggins (dated within 12 months of show) and a copy of your 2019 RMDS Horse/Rider/Owner Card for scores if you wish to qualify for RMDS Championships and year-end awards. Riders or their representative must have a minimum of 4 volunteer hours in the current competition year recorded at RMDS to be eligible for year-end awards. To qualify as an Adult Amateur, include copy of your 2019 USEF card. Mail entry with required documents to Secretary Simone Windeler at 19525 Twisted Pine Drive, Colorado Springs, CO 80908. Also enter online at www.theelegant rider.com. Go to shows and then to Foothills Entry. If entering online you must upload your proof of vaccinations and Coggins. You may also upload your 2019 USEF card and 2019 RMDS card. Online entry requires the use of PayPal. An additional fee for entering online will apply.

FEES \$30 for one class and \$55 for two classes. No additional divisions or cross entries. **\$35 non-refundable Office Fee.** \$25 for each change after closing date. Post entries accepted with management OK and \$25 fee. \$50 for returned checks. Horses on grounds for schooling only must pay office fee, provide proof of vaccinations and Coggins and wear bridle tag. Also must fill out an entry form.

RIDE TIMES Tentative ride times will be sent via e-mail by Thursday, 9 p.m., before the show and also will be available at www.theelegant rider.com. Ride times are final at noon the day prior to the show.

REFUNDS Office fee is non-refundable. Before closing date, entire entry minus office fee will be refunded. After closing day to day before show, refunds will be only for class fee if ride(s) can be filled. During competition, no refunds of any kind for any reason. No refunds due to acts of nature, including acts of God.

AWARDS Ribbons to sixth place. High point awards for all Divisions.

WESTERN DRESSAGE ASSOCIATION of COLORADO has qualified both of these shows for their High Point year-end award program.

STABLING Stabling and pens may be available on a first-come basis. Stabled horses at TMR must have current health certificate. To reserve, contact Table Mountain Ranch, (303) 278-3285 <http://tablemountainranch.net/>. Pay TMR.

REQUIRED FOR RIDERS Anyone on horseback must wear protective headgear with harness secured.

ARENA All tests ridden outdoors in standard 20 x 60-meter arena (or 20 x 40-meter for eventing tests) with mixed pea gravel and wood chip footing (or equivalent); warm-up in large outdoor sand arena. Indoor arena only for lunging.

DIRECTIONS From the west, at stoplight turn east from Highway 93 (between Golden and Boulder) onto W 58th Avenue. Drive 0.7 miles on W 58th Avenue. Table Mountain Ranch and parking is on right side of street at Devils Head Court. View map at <http://www.tablemountainranch.net/contact-us>.
