Refunds: Up to one week before show date, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. During competition no refunds including Acts of God. *Office fee is non-refundable.*

Awards: Ribbons to 5th place all divisions. Management reserves the right to break ties. This is a series over 3 shows – special awards to the overall highpoint in all divisions. High point riders will be determined via a golf score – must participate in at least 2 shows to be eligible.

Directions: 15385 Black Forest Road, Black Forest, CO 80908

From Hwy 83 – head east on Hodgen Road (approx. 2 miles) to Black Forest Road to the south. Turn right onto Black Forest Road. The barn and indoor will be on your left side (east of the road). Follow parking instructions.

Dress is casual, however a boot with heel and ASTM safety helmet are required at all times while mounted. Exception for riders in Western gear, though we highly recommend a safety helmet.

We reserve the right to combine, split or cancel classes based on entries. Intro and Training Level classes may be offered in small arena as well as the Eventing and Intro and Basic Western Dressage tests.

No dogs are allowed on the show grounds.
