Refunds: Up to one week before show date, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to the day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. During competition no refunds including Acts of God. *Office fee is non-refundable.*

Awards: Ribbons to 4th place all divisions. Management reserves the right to break ties.

Important Note on Scheduling:

We normally run all USDF Intro tests, WDAA Intro and Basic tests, all USEA Eventing tests, and all USA WE tests in the small arena (20x40m). If you are planning on riding USDF Intro and also USEF Training level then you most likely will have one ride in the morning and one in the afternoon. We do our best to let you ride your lower test before your higher level test but that is not always possible in the schedule. If you have questions on which tests to choose based on this information – please contact Simone.

Directions: 18020 Eastonville Road, Elbert, CO 80106

From Hwy 83 – head east on Hodgen Road (approx. 10 miles) to Eastonville Road. Turn left (north) on Eastonville Road – you are now on a dirt road, follow the road for about 2 miles. The barn and indoor will be on your left side (east of the road). Follow parking instructions.

Dress is casual, however a boot with heel and ASTM safety helmet are required at all times while mounted. This includes riders in Western gear due to insurance requirements.

We reserve the right to combine, split or cancel classes based on entries. Intro and Training Level classes may be offered in small arena as well as the Eventing and Intro and Basic Western Dressage tests. No dogs are allowed on the show grounds.
